<b>One Rescuer Assessment</b>			
Scene Safety			
Check the victim's response			
Shout for help and ask for AED			
Check Breathing (5-10 sec)			
<b>Compression</b>			
Hands Placement (lower half of the chest bone)			
Depth (at least 2in/5cm)			
Rate (100-120/min)			
Complete Chest Recoil			
30 Chest Compressions			
<b>Breathing</b>			
Provide two breaths (Each breath has to be over one second with visible chest rise)			
Return to compressions within 10 seconds			
<b>The Instructor Says: The 2<sup>nd</sup> rescuer has arrived and will give breath (BVM). The 1<sup>st</sup> rescuer will be evaluated for the 15-chest compression</b>			
Hand placement			
Chest compression (15:2 ratio)			
<b>The instructor says the 2 minutes is over (switch role). The 2<sup>nd</sup> rescuer will do 15 compressions and the 1<sup>st</sup> rescuer will be evaluated for giving breaths</b>			
Provides 2 breaths with BVM
